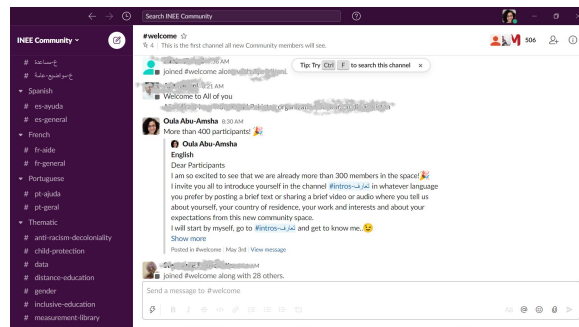
Community of Practice

The CoP gives INEE members a voice

The CoP aims to encourage networking, experience sharing, and collaborative actions.

It provides:

- Communication mainly using texts and emojis, shared documents and polls
- Dynamic set of moderated thematic and linguistic channels in the INEE five languages
- Peer-to-peer modalities in any language
- Accessible and affordable on most devices



Why use Slack?

Slack is a **channel-based**, **real-time** messaging platform that is available on many devices

- A social place that is **only** dedicated to EiE → **Less Distraction**
- Available and affordable on mobile phones in limited connectivity contexts → **Inclusive**
- Provides similar, yet better organized, services as the ubiquitous WhatsApp → **User-friendly**
- Identification with an email address (that we hide!) → **Privacy protected**

Key functions:

- Editing & Deleting your own messages
- Threading to keep discussions organized
- Emojis for quick and simple reactions
- Search throughout the workspace
- Notifications to keep you informed
- File Sharing of most file types
- Audio/Video Calls up to 15 people

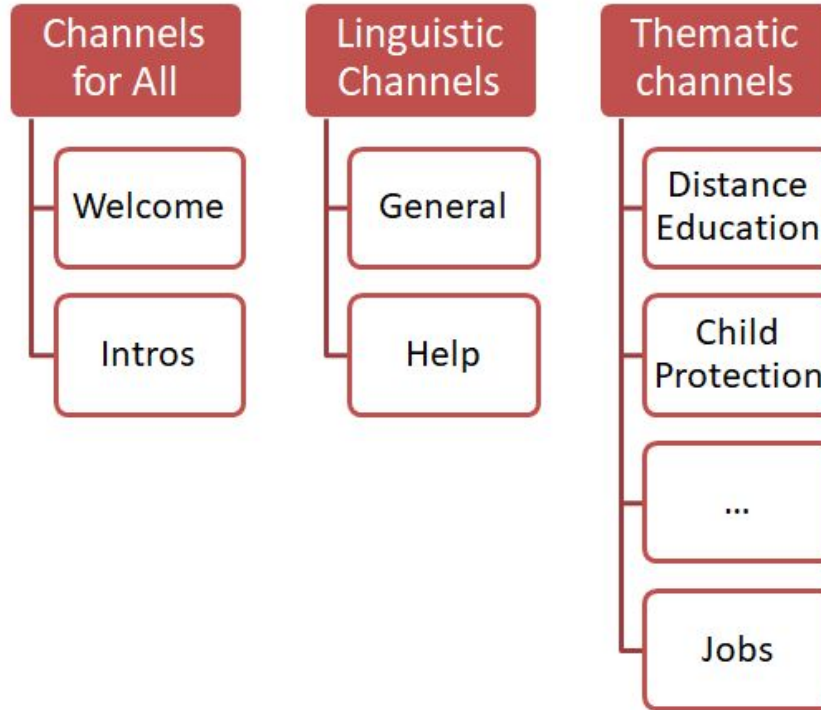

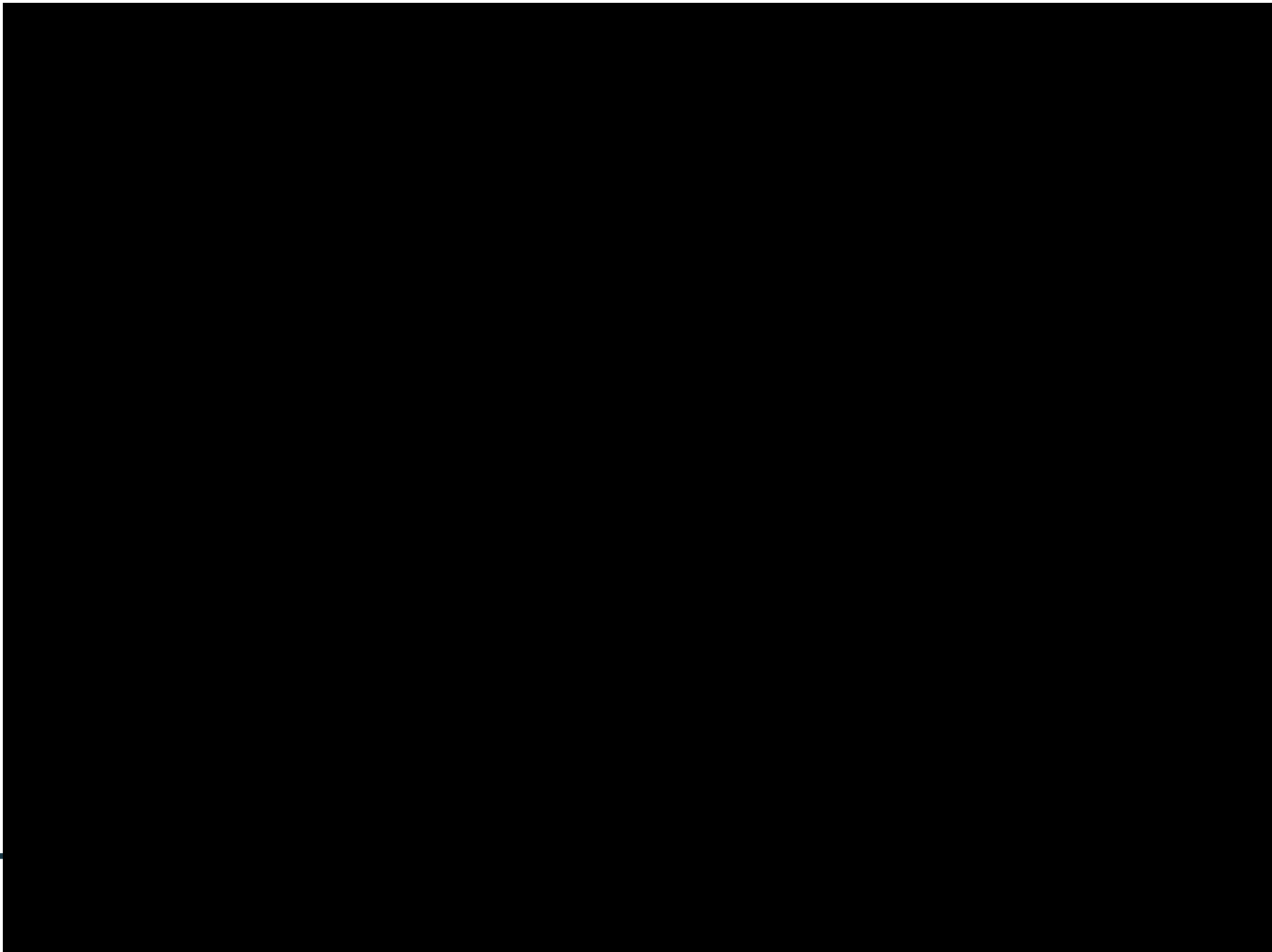

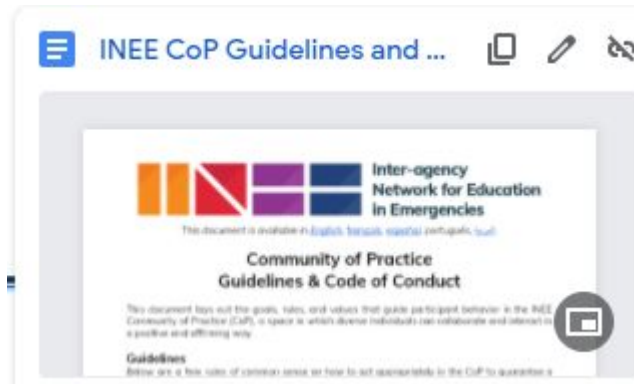
