I DEAL helps War Child Holland project and partner staff to guide children and young people in gaining life skills to cope with life after armed conflict. The healthy development of a child can be disrupted during a period of armed conflict which may prevent essential life skills from sufficiently developing. Through I DEAL we invite children to rediscover their identities and creatively acquire life skills that help them grow up into balanced adults. I DEAL calls upon the capacity and resilience of individuals to cope with problems and difficult experiences. It aims to re-establish the child's sense of self and purpose, preparing for his or her future.

Identity and Assessment




